Christmas





Interactive board

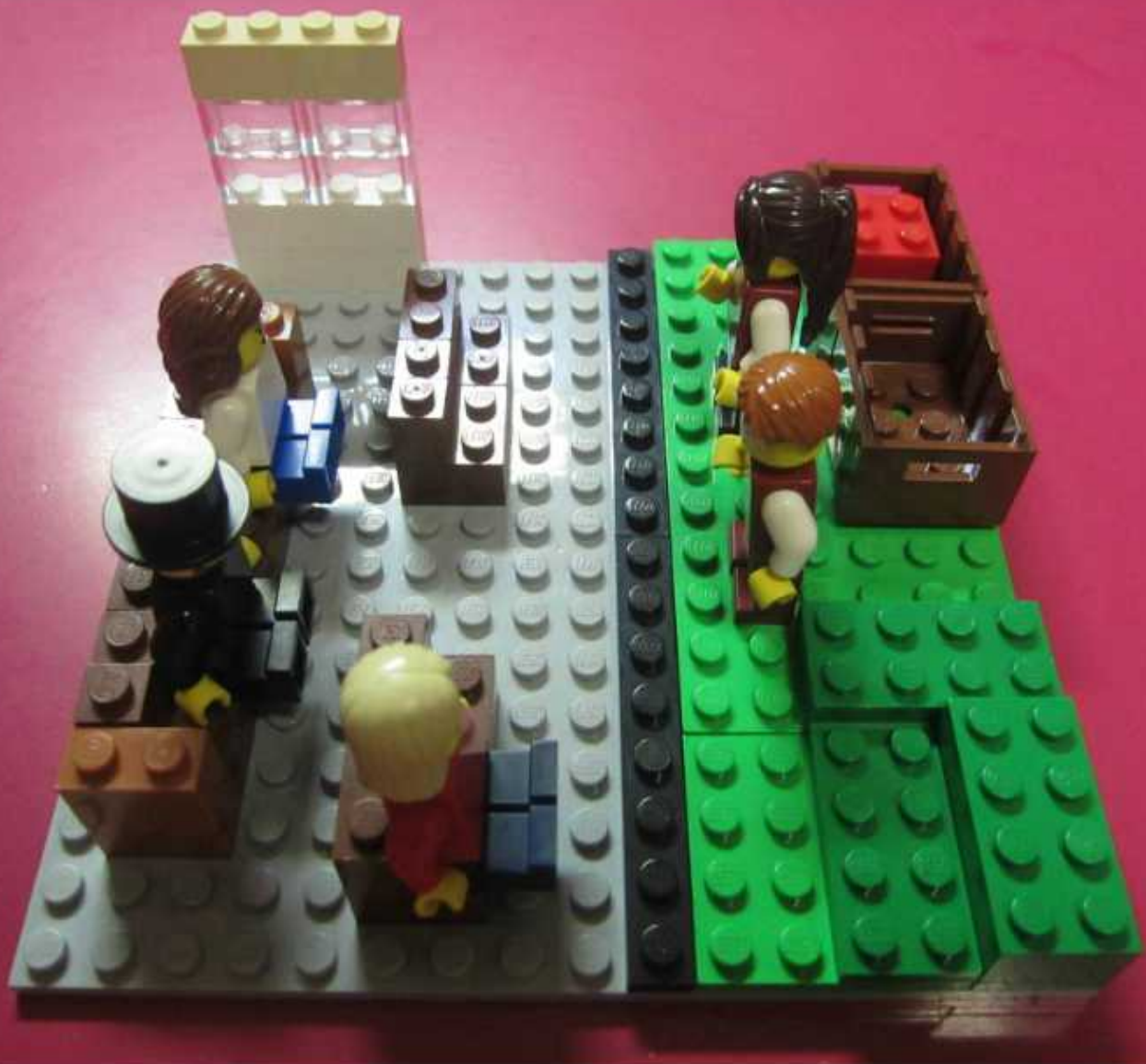
